Trade Adjustment Assistance for Firms (TAAF)

## **Pump Manufacturer**

#### **CHALLENGE**

Competition from lower cost products from China and other countries

In the two years prior to starting TAAF:

Sales Change: -26%
Jobs Change: -14%

NWTAAC assisted company to prepare a petition for TAAF

Often an increase in employment precedes an expected increase in sales.

NWTAAC worked with management to review and advise on a strategy to build on advantages in quality, design, technology, and service while improving communication to customer base.

Investment

NWTAAC secured approval for \$30,000 for outside expertise with the company matching at 25% (\$7,500). The company invested substantial additional funds to fully implement the strategy.

#### **RESULTS**

TAAF focused on marketing objectives. The company was able to find a stable market position based on its strategy and customer relationships. The firm employed \$13,350 of TAAF assistance over 5 years.
